# LEGO ROBOTICS AND PROGRAMMING






Students in KS3 Secondary have been using their problem solving and critical thinking skills to design and transform block coding using Lego Mindstorm EV3.

## **BSME APP CREATION**






#### \*\*\* Competition Time \*\*\*






