Our Scholarships are granted to applicants who stand out in one of the following fields:



All students who are granted Scholarships are expected to lead by example and serve as a role model to their peer group.

Scholars will be given regular opportunities for prominence and leadership within their given specialism. Academic scholars will be expected to maintain high standards of performance across the curriculum.

DESCRIPTION

Conditions for Scholarship Awards

Awards are granted by a Scholarship Committee which is chaired by the Director of Enrichment and Enhancement, supported by the Principal and other key members of the leadership team. The recommendations of the Committee will be submitted to Cognita for final approval.

Awards will be reviewed at the end of each Key Stage for a Scholar's continued outstanding performance, exemplary disciplinary record and overall positive attitude to school.

Scholarship renewal will be confirmed to students in writing by the end of Term 3 for the following academic year. Scholars would be expected to be in the top 5% nationally in their area of excellence.

🗲 Academic Scholars

Academic Scholarships are awarded on a range of criteria:

Full report from the candidate's present school. It is essential that this contains both local ranking ('top of the class') and national ranking ('top 5%'), school and national test or exam results (GCSE results if applicable).

- Student interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- Verbal and non-verbal reasoning test from the CAT4 if available.
- Progress tests in English, Maths and Science, if applicable.
- It is desirable, Scholars in Year 11 will choose to study A Level academic subjects.

Sports Scholars

To be granted a sports Scholarship, applicants should have developed significantly above-average sporting ability in one or more sports. Local or national representational honours are also taken into consideration.

If the course is available, it is desirable, Scholars in Year 10 to choose GCSE PE as one of their options. In Year 12, if there are study options available in Post 16, Scholars would ideally choose to study a sports course and gain coaching qualifications.

All sports Scholars should be contributing to their chosen sport or sports, through extra-curricular opportunities both within school and externally.

Creative and Performing Arts Scholars

Music scholars should hold or be near to Grade 3 level (UK) or regional equivalent and have a proven record of membership in an orchestra/ensemble, and/or a proven performance record. Students who are skilled in composition should provide a portfolio of work. Candidates must audition. Performing Arts students in the areas of dance and drama should have graded examination results from LAMDA, Trinity or the equivalent. Candidates must audition. Art students must produce a portfolio with a range of artwork.

FINANCIALS

Scholarships are not necessarily limited to one academic year. They will be reviewed at the end of each Key Stage based on their progress and the wider contribution a student/scholar makes.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

Up to 25% concession on tuition fees

HOW TO APPLY

If a student is achieving significantly ahead of his or her related age group and predominantly attaining above age related expectations, or has been recognised and won awards, are eligible to apply to the Horizon International School Scholarship Programme.

Step 1

To apply for a Scholarship a student must

- Be enrolled as a HIS Student.
- Only apply for one scholarship field.
- Be a Secondary student from Y7 to Y12 at the start of the academic year 2025-26.
- Complete the application form in full.
- Submit a cover letter explaining why he/she should be considered for a scholarship (student written).
- Include his/her last two school reports.
- Include CAT4 test results, if available. These can be requested from school.
- Include progress tests in English, Maths and Science (if applicable).
- Include GCSE assessment predictions or results (if applicable).
- Include proof of achievement in the selected scholarship area.
- Ensure the application form is submitted within the required time frame. Applications can be submitted via email to scholarships@hisdubai.ae

Step 2

- All applications will be screened and processed by the Scholarship Committee. Students who are shortlisted will be invited to attend an interview with the Scholarship Committee.
- Applicants who are not selected for an interview will be informed via e-mail as soon as possible.

Step 3

- The applicant will attend an interview with the Scholarship Committee. The school requests that at least one parent waits at the school while the interview is taking place for any additional queries.
- Applicants will be required to bring a portfolio with evidence of achievements in the chosen Scholarship.

Step 4

- The Scholarship Committee will decide on merit which students will be awarded scholarships.
- The Principal will send recommendations for scholarships to the DoE of Cognita for final approval.
- The decision of the Scholarship Committee and DoE of Cognita is final and there in no process for appeal.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Application

- **1.** Only complete applications accompanied by the required supporting documents will be considered for the Horizon International School Scholarship Programme. Applications will not be considered if the required information and documents are incomplete or not submitted.
- **2.** There is a limited number of scholarships available. Scholarships are awarded on merit. Horizon International School does not guarantee that a scholarship will be awarded. The school accepts no liability for expenses or damages an applicant may incur when applying to the Scholarship Programme.
- 3. Scholarships are subject to applicants meeting the entry criteria.
- **4.** Applicants may apply for only one type of Scholarship.
- 5. Applicants will be assessed according to the criteria specified for each Scholarship field.
- 6. Successful applicants will be issued an Offer Letter outlining award details.
- **7.** Applicants must respond in writing to the Offer Letter within the given time frame to accept the offered Scholarship. If the offer is declined by the applicant, or not accepted within the given time frame, Horizon International School may withdraw the offer of scholarship and offer it to another candidate.
- 8. The terms of the scholarship as stated in the Offer Letter are non-negotiable and non-transferable.
- **9.** Unsuccessful applicants will be notified by e-mail as soon as possible. The school reserves the right not to give individualised feedback regarding any decision made by the Scholarship Committee.
- **10.** Applicants must apply within the Scholarship application window.

Fees

- **11.** Scholarships cannot be combined with any other discount or special offer.
- **12.** Students awarded Scholarships are eligible for a reduction on their annual tuition fees. The percentage and the academic year(s) are outlined in the Offer Letter.
- **13.** If a student has outstanding tuition fees when the Scholarship is offered, these fees must be settled in full prior to Horizon International School accepting the student into the Scholarship Programme.

Continuation of Scholarship

14. The continuation of a Scholarship is subject to the students:

- Making considerable contributions in the Scholarship field with school and externally.
- Keeping an excellent attendance record
- Meeting the school's behavioural expectations
- Completing assigned work in the time frame provided
- Representing the school when opportunities arise
- Working towards continuous improvement and development within the Scholarship field
- Leading by example and acting as a role model to others
- To actively seek opportunities and volunteer to support whole school events
- **15.** If the student fails to comply with the above criteria or falls consistently below the expected levels required for the Scholarship, Horizon International School has the right to withdraw the Scholarship at the end of the academic term.

Marketing & Promotions

- **16.** Scholarship recipients agree to become ambassadors for Horizon International School, undertaking activities agreed as reasonable and acceptable by the student and the Principal.
- **17.** Students and their parents will grant permission for Horizon International School to use the students' names and photographs in any publication, advertising/marketing materials and social media channels associated with Horizon International School.
- **18.** Students may be required to represent Horizon International School in local, regional, national, or international competitions relevant to their area of Scholarship. Photographs and videos of students at such events may be used for promotional purposes.
- **19** Horizon International School reserves the right to make changes or amendments to the Terms and Conditions and agrees to give the student and his/her parents four weeks' written notice of intention.
- **20** The Terms and Conditions of this policy shall come under jurisdiction of the laws of the United Arab Emirates.


